

2013 CLINIC RULES TEST A

17. 3/5 B40. A14 receives snap, and he hands off to A27 on a reverse. A27 rolls right and plans to throw a pass. He cannot find a receiver, so he throws the ball 10 yards downfield and across the SL.

Answer: ING – LOD at spot of A27's pass. Tackle-box exception applies only to the player that controls the snap or resulting backward pass (AR 7-3-2- IX)

18. Team A is out of timeouts. 2Q with less than a minute to play. Team A completes a pass for a 9-yard gain on first down. Team A rushes to the line after the ball is placed ready for play. A14 spikes the ball upon receiving the snap. Team A is flagged for illegal formation. The clock shows 0:10. Clock?

Answer: 2/6 after 5-yard penalty at PS; SNAP (AR 7-3-2-VII)

19. 2/5 A40. A77 goes to three-point stance after U sets the ball down and center is on the ball. Team A substitutes which brings U to ball to allow defense to adjust. A77 lefts his hand and moves a step to his left.

Answer: Legal – not FST. U coming to ball interrupted the readiness of the ball being ready for play (2012 Bulletin #2, play 3)

20. 2/8 B20. A14 drops straight back in tackle box. A77 is beat by B83 on B83's pass rush. A77 shoves B83 in the back knocking him to the ground. A14 completes a pass for a TD.

Answer: Legal – not a foul by A77 (AR 9-3-3-IX) NEW AR THAT REQUIRES DISCUSSION
